Dr. Diane Christian will discuss many important topics related to raising children who have low vision. She will discuss ways to not cause other children in the family to feel neglected, how to promote independence, and how to instill confidence in the children.

JULY 9, 2019 7:00 P.M. SHOULD YOUR CHILD WEAR SUNGLASSES?

There are many discussions on whether infants and children should protect their eyes from the harmful rays of the sun. Dr. Bill Takeshita will explain the various situations when it is important to protect the eyes of children and also when sunglasses should not be used.

AUGUST 13, 2019 7:00 P.M. TIPS ON HOW TO DECORATE YOUR HOME AND YOUR CHILD'S ROOM TO DEVELOP VISION

Dr. Bill Takeshita will provide specific recommendations on how to paint your child's room, decorate the room, and how to create a visually stimulating environment.

The visual system is directly related to the movement centers of the brain. Dr. Bill will describe activities to perform to encourage your child to move more safely.

Computers are one of the most enjoyable and helpful tools for children. Dr. Bill Takeshita describes features of various computers, software, and games that are very helpful for children with low vision.

Many children have difficulty seeing food on their plate if the food is similar in color. For example, it can be difficult to see mashed potatoes on a white plate. Dr. Bill shares ideas on how to make eating a more enjoyable activity for children with low vision.

DECEMBER 10, 2019 7:00 P.M. TOYS FOR CHILDREN WITH VISUAL IMPAIRMENT

During the holiday season, toys can be very difficult to purchase for young children. Dr. Bill Takeshita will describe the most effective toys for children with low vision.
